Taking your purchase across the U.S./Canada border



To take your plant purchase across the border into the U.S., you will require a phytosanitary certificate issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CIFA).

PLEASE CALL THE CANADIAN FOOD INSPECTION AGENCY TO SET-UP AN APPOINTMENT TO HAVE YOUR PLANT PURCHASE INSPECTED.

If you are planning to cross the 264th or Huntington border crossings, we suggest going to the Abbotsford office, located at:

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency is open from 8am – 4pm Monday – Friday and charges \$12.35 to write up a phytosanitary certificate.

*Please note that CIFA will need an itemized list of plants that they are inspecting so be sure to provide a handwritten summary of your plant purchases e.g. 5 Mixed hanging baskets, 6 Geraniums, 1 bedding flat Coleus, 2 bedding packs Marigold, etc.
